5. Explain the post mortem changes in a human body and the estimation of time since death.
6. Explain the symptoms of death by poisoning. Discuss the importance of preservation of body fluids and viscera in cases of suspected poisoning.
7. Examine the medico-legal aspects of precipitate labour. Enumerate the signs of recent delivery that can be found during an autopsy.
