2. The flour entrusted with Alex, a mercantile agent, is pawned by him. Is the pledge valid as against the claim of its real owner?

3. Ali gave possession of some jewels to Jamal to sell by auction. Jamal tries to sell them by auction but is forced to cancel the conduct of the auction and has to pay damages to Mustafa who establishes his ownership over the goods through proceedings in a court of law. Jamal sues Ali for indemnification of the amount he had to pay Mustafa and for damage to his reputation as an owner. Decide.
