- IX. X is a Muslim. Distribute his property, by applying the relevant rules under Sunni and Shia law in the following situations:
  - a. The surviving heirs are one daughter of a predeceased son, two sons of a predeceased daughter, father and a full brother.
  - b. The surviving heirs are full brother, mother's father and father's mother.
- X. Explain the rules by which a female Hindu's intestate property is distributed. Apply the rules in a situation where a Hindu female dies intestate leaving behind, her mother, brother and mother-in-law. Her property includes self-acquired property and the property inherited from her father. Distribute the property among the heirs as if:
  - a. X is governed by the general rules of succession
  - b. X is governed by the Marumakkathayam law

- XI. What is meant by Letters of administration? What are the powers and duties of an administrator with respect to the deceased person's property?
- XII. Explain the rules of intestate succession applicable to Christians. Distribute the intestate property by applying the rules, in the following situations:
