- 5. What do you understand by Open Source movements? How are they relevant to discussions of access, affordability and availability in the context of intellectual property rights?
- 6. Explain the significance of Government and Research Exceptions under TRIPS and the Indian patent law.
- 7. "The WTO Agreement enables its members to waive an obligation in exceptional circumstances by consensus-based decision-making". Elaborate on this statement in the context of COVID-19, and elucidate the current position of the same.
- 8. Explain the significance of intellectual property in international trade involving digital goods and services.
