- 1. How are concepts of subrogation and tacking dealt with under the Transfer of Property Act?
- 2. What is a lease? Trace the provisions in the Transfer of Property Act related to duration and determination of lease.
- 3. Trace the provisions in the Transfer of Property Act related to transfer of actionable claim.
- 4. Explain acquisition of easements by prescription. Also identify the rights which cannot be acquired by prescription.
- 5. What is a property? How is it classified into movable and immovable property? What is the significance of such a classification?
- 6. A, who is the owner of a house X, transfers it for consideration to B. In the transfer deed, A puts a condition that B would not sell it to anyone, but would keep the possession of the property to himself. B agrees to abide by this condition and pays consideration. After the title passes and the property vests in B, B sells it to C. A files a suit claiming possession of the property on the ground that B has committed a breach of a condition of the contract, and therefore, the sale in favour of C is void. Identify whether the suit filed by A is valid.
