4. Define Privacy. What do you understand by informational privacy? Elucidate the Indian legal position in the protection of privacy.
5. “The right to privacy is inextricably bound with all exercises of human liberty”. Clarify this statement, while elaborating on the link between liberty and privacy.
6. What are domain names? Explain the international mechanisms in place to resolve Trademark-Domain name disputes.
