ORDER

Some ambiguities regarding flowers trading and flower arrangement related to the Onam celebration have come to notice. The following clarifications are issued by taking the prevailing epidemic and safety of people into consideration. In partial modification of reference 1 cited, the flower vendors from outside Kerala are permitted in Kerala during the Onam festival period. They shall strictly adhere to the following advisory.

Category	Advice
Freight transporters of	Shall wear mask and practice frequent hand washing
flowers	Practice cough and sneeze hygiene
	 Wash hands with soap and water after handling flowers and packages
	• Shall ensure that they do not mix with other traders and florists unnecessarily
	• The package of the flowers should be disposed of properly and immediately do hand wash

Shall wear mask and practice frequent hand washing
 Shall ensure that physical distancing, wearing of mask are practiced by buyers and staff
Practice cough and sneeze hygiene
 Wash hands after touching and handling flowers and packages
Prefer cashless transactions
• The package of the flowers should be disposed of properly and immediately do hand wash
• As far as possible it is better to avoid congregation
Shall wear mask and practice frequent hand washing
 Shall maintain physical distancing while doing flower arrangements and shall take turns rather than doing it collectively at the same time
Materials should not be shared between the participants
• The package of the flowers should be disposed of properly and immediately do hand wash.

All formalities such as registration in e-Jagratha to be followed up by the traders and transporters. Any symptomatic person should immediately call DISHA 1056 for advice.
