- II. Isaac, a partner, absconds with cash entrusted by Safwan with the partnership. Is Vishnu, the partner of Isaac, liable to indemnify Safwan? If Isaac was only an employee and not a partner, what would be the liability of Vishnu?
- III. Mustafa, a general merchant, instructs his agent Jamal, to pay out of the money entrusted with him for purchase of goods, the dues owed to Joseph. When Joseph comes to receive his dues Jamal discovers that the money due is for supply of wine for personal use of Mustafa. Can Jamal refuse to pay? Decide.
- IV. Sudha is refused payment by the bank citing insufficiency of funds in the account for the cheque she submitted for rupees ten thousand. Due to non receipt of this amount she is unable to pay the balance required and forfeits the deposit of rupees five thousand she had made for an auction purchase. In a claim under the Negotiable Instruments Act for dishonour of cheque, can Sudha claim for the loss of the auction purchase, the deposit amount and the amount on the cheque? Advise.
