A Hindu couple has a minor child. The father of the child dies leaving behind a will whereby he appoints his brother as the guardian of the child. Later on, the mother of the child appoints her sister as the guardian of the child by her will and dies during the minority of the child. Who can be considered to be the guardian of the child according to the Hindu law?

Maria and John got married according to Christian law. Within a few days after the marriage John XI. started to ill-treat Maria. He continuously made allegations of adultery against her and family compelled her to leave the matrimonial home. Advise Maria regarding the remedies available under different laws.
