**Answer any five of the following questions. Each question carries ten marks. (5x10=50)**

1. Indian Constitution aims at Social revolution'. Examine how the amending power under Art 368 justifies the objectives of the Constitution.
2. How do you distinguish ordinary law making power from that of the Constituent power?
3. Most constitutions derive their claim to authority from having been enacted by the people, a concept called popular sovereignty. However primary constituent power which is the same as popular sovereignty is rather a fallacy. Comment
4. Examine the grounds for judicial review of Constitutional Amendments.
5. Elucidate the parameters that a judge must take cognizance of in deciding the width, scope and span of the power to amend the Constitution.
6. Elucidate with the help of judicial decisions what amounts to basic structure of the Constitution. Do fundamental rights form part of the Basic Structure of the Constitution?
7. Give an account of the origin and the purpose behind insertion of ninth schedule to the Constitution. Examine the scope of protection available to ninth schedule legislations.
8. Examine the scope of Art 31B and ninth schedule. Elucidate the implication of judicial review of ninth schedule legislations.
