- I. Define culpable homicide. Explain the circumstances under which culpable homicide will become murder.
- II. What is custodial rape? Is consent a defence to a charge of custodial rape? Refer to recent amendments made in this case.
- III. Explain criminal force and assault defined in the Indian Penal Code. Discuss recent amendments made in the Penal Code incorporating new offences relating to this.
- IV. What is criminal trespass? Examine aggravated forms of trespass and various punishments prescribed for these offences.
- V. Distinguish between
 - (a) Insult and Intimidation
 - (b) Hurt and Grievous hurt
 - (c) Kidnapping and Abduction
- VI. Tom, entrusted his watch with a watch repair named Sakker for repair. Sakker repaired the watch and kept it in his shop. Tom took his watch when Sakker was not in the shop without the consent and knowledge of Sakker. What offence, if any, has Tom committed?
- VII. Examine the ingredients of the offence defamation. Discuss the different defences given to a person accused of defamation.
